EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: KEY CRITICAL BIBLICAL ISSUES THAT CONFRONT US

(The Biblical Worldview)

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God designed history's events to bring us to a mature high-skill spiritual ability in Christ-likeness. God commands that we pursue this mature spiritual ability. It is needed for us to know and relate to our perfect God toward His depth in eternity according to His perfect Truth in His holiness and righteousness. It is so we can live perfect lives without sin amidst His great glory. We can live forever in fellowship with Him and each other. We can glorify God and enjoy Him forever. Apart from this, there is nothing.

However, we are born in Satan's Dominion with depraved natures that sin, do not seek after God, and are without ability to pursue this maturity. This sin is lawlessness, breaking God's spiritual laws. This requires God's justice to be satisfied that man is without ability to accomplish.

The Lord Jesus Christ satisfied this justice for us on the Cross. When man receives this satisfied Justice by faith as God works in him, this satisfied justice is applied to man's personal account. As this happens, man is translated from Satan's Dominion into God's Kingdom, becoming Christ's Church. God produces in him a new creation with a new divine nature that, as led of God, can pursue this maturity in Christ-likeness without sin. However, he still retains the depraved nature that when used continues to sin.

Our Lord, as His Great Commission, has entrusted the churches with the tasks to evangelize the **entirety** of local and foreign areas with the Gospel (the satisfaction of God's Justice by Christ) so all can go to heaven and afterwards to disciple converts to this **maximum** maturity in Christ.

As a method to develop and test spiritual ability, God established a spiritual warfare between Christ and Satan. Christ leads people to obey God doing right. Satan deceives people to disobey God doing wrong. For Satan to win the warfare, He must prevent some of God's elect from believing the Gospel and/or prevent the elect from accomplishing some of God's chosen work. Thus, he works so the elect might not be born and has churches teach but little of the Bible so their people will not become greatly mature. Generally the mature people do God's work.

Where there are exceptions, many, if not most, of our churches are teaching mostly first-level training for spiritual growth without also teaching in depth to bring their people to a mature high-skill spiritual ability in Christ. The Bible teaches we are not to continue in only first-level training, but we are to pursue maturity in Christ (Hebrews 6:1). They are doing some evangelism, but generally are not attempting to evangelize their entire local areas. They are not carrying out the Great Commission's intent and scope. Because the more mature do God's work, the churches are implementing satanic strategy. They implement his strategy also by using the world's loud rock-type beat music that, by emphasizing body movement, impedes spiritual growth and commitment. As a result, our Church people now do not know and cannot teach the Bible comprehensively. We are losing (have lost) our biblical intellect. We are becoming (have become) the immature Church. We will know and can relate to God less in eternity.

Watchman Warning -Signs and conditions now signal and warn that Revelation's Tribulation, a special endtimes sequence, bringing calamity (war, famine, and plague) followed by an evil world government can come at any time. The government will remove freedoms, confiscate real estate, bring population control and travel restrictions, and satanically educate our children. It will make war with the Church, martyring Christians and Patriots. The Tribulation brings divine judgment on the Church and

the world's people for their sin. With the calamity, the infrastructure will break down. We can be without electricity, food, water, gasoline, goods, and communications for long periods. Toiletry and finances will be serious problems.

The Tribulation's purposes, in addition to bringing divine discipline, is to polarize formally all the people's beliefs regarding their accepting or denying the Gospel, and is how Christ wins back the Earth's Title Deed from Satan.

Churches should urgently now mature their people, particularly their children and youth, with a version of God's Whole Counsel to know and relate to God by training them to glorify, worship, and obey God, live godly relationships, help accomplish God's work, to stand strong on Christian-Faith Doctrines, and know prophetic doctrines. They should place their people into small support groups and put in supplies to get through the calamity period.

After the Tribulation, the heavenly court determines that Christ wins the warfare. It awards Him the authority to end history. He resurrects and raptures the Church, taking her to the new Jerusalem to live with Him forever. He kills the unbelievers. He casts Satan and his angels into the Lake of Fire. He resurrects and judges all unbelievers. He casts them away from God eternally into the Lake of Fire as an alternate way for God to satisfy His Justice for sin.

As the Church enters eternity, her sin nature with all its memories are removed from her. She enters heaven with her divine nature with its memories and with the maturity in Christ she develops in this lifetime. Can our maturities increase in heaven? We are not told. God left it as a matter of faith. But what if it is fixed forever, and we do not pursue it? Gaining maturity now is important to God for He commands we pursue it. Thus, it should be important to us. God may use it differently than we can know now. In eternity, God will direct us according to His will and our spiritual abilities. We will not take any independent action. It will be God all in all. We will live holy without sin.
