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**PART ONE  
ORIENTATION TO KEY ITEMS**

**1. We Have a Most Perfect God That Exists Who Has Created Us to Have a Perfect Life in Relationship with Him (And to Each Other) in Eternity. In My Understanding, We must Appreciate God’s Infinite Greatness and Be Outcome Oriented Such That We Train Under His Leadership Now to Live Out His Ways in Our Personal Lives and Families to Become Maximumly Mature in Christ-likeness both now and “Especially in Eternity” with Excellence.●<sup>2</sup>**

For life to have real meaning, we need to be working to gain specific outcomes as required by God, not just living life. Examples of these outcomes in the spiritual realm would include (only from the Bible that God gave us):

- 1. We would be working under God’s direction to live out that necessary to gain maximum maturity in Christ-likeness (Christ lives a perfect life under God the Father) so we can relate to and know our most perfect God maximumly toward His maximum now and especially in eternity, both personally and in our families. (For this to happen we need a curriculum (a version of God’s Whole Council) of a description of what we are like when we are maximumly mature (not just having some Christian growth) and what steps we must live out experientially, to be trained, to gain this maximum maturity, from the Bible.)●<sup>3</sup>**
- 2. We would go all out to evangelize and disciple to maturity the children and youth out in our communities so that our adult ministries will continue in greatness and our**

**2. GOD IS IN CHARGE OF OUR LIVES BOTH NOW AND IN ETERNITY:** Whether we know, believe, or like it, God, having infinite and perfect Greatness without any sin or error of any amount, created us and is in control of our lives now and in eternity. He will do what is best and what He wants according to His will and character. We must obey Him so that He effectively works all things together for our good, according to His perfection. He will direct our every thought and action in eternity. We are not qualified to do so. Thus, it is essential, we must be sure to respond now to God’s leading as He works in us to become Christians and obey Him to become maximally mature in Christ-likeness. This is the correct thing to do because of His infinite perfection and eternal control - and there is nothing else.

HELPFUL TRAINING CURRICULUMS (we update as we learn more):** Under Training on my web site: **(1) *Keys to Becoming Mature in Christ-likeness In Godly Relationship Living*** (33 pages); and **(2) *Summary Document: Signs, Characteristics, Beliefs, and Practices of Being or Becoming Highly Mature in Christ-likeness*** (21 pages).(The latter document gives us many principles we must live out experientially.)

**children and youth will be saved.** (Statistics show that 85% of the people who come to Christ to be saved do so in the age range of 4-14 years. If we want our adult ministries to continue in greatness, we must evangelize and have God save the children.)

- 3. We would choose and use music type “from the Bible - from God” in our church worship services (and Sunday Schools) to bring our maximum worship to God, “from His perspective.” We would preach sermons that describe the Greatness of God and biblical details for how we are to live under His Greatness.** (This implies we, when filled with the Holy Spirit, would use music that has the melody dominate that we sing from our hearts unto the Lord that describes His Greatness (Ephesians 5:18-19). We would have in-depth sermons, from love, with expository preaching, verse by verse, with many examples and testimonies.●<sup>4</sup>

**NOTE:** If we use the world’s music and low level teaching in our church services and have a similar Sunday School, then why come to Church. **We are not adequately obeying God and bringing Him maximum worship “from His perspective,” by our attempting to work all things together for our good. This is major sin.** These churches have lost much of their excellence before God and are falling away, departing from God’s Greatness and, as a result, can be somewhat lukewarm, without their realization or desire. **As a result, they have been transformed away from God’s Greatness and are helping the endtimes Tribulation to come. (What is your church and my church doing?)**

**2. The Main Concept of Understanding (Input, according to our understanding, from the Holy Bible, whose source is only from God.)**

God has designed this lifetime for the purposes that all responding people to His leading will first become Christians in order to go to heaven and then, most importantly afterwards in a growth process, gain a “maximum” spiritual maturity in Christ-likeness. This is so that throughout eternity they (we) can relate to and know our most perfect God (and each other) toward His maximum and to have the most and only perfect life that exists. Thus, we now must be sure to respond to God to become Christians and then, afterwards, over our lifetimes, seek to become as “maximumly” mature in Christ-likeness as we can as God works in us. **Apart from these in a relationship to God, there is nothing.** None of us most likely are completely there yet, but we can work to obey God in that direction. We can help each other. All Christians will have some maturity at death. He, as presented in His Holy Bible, commands that we become Christians and then pursue this maximum maturity (perfection). Both result from a responsive life, by faith, obeying what God is working in us. It is not something we do

ALTERNATIVELY:** If, alternatively, our main goal is to bring in numbers of the youth into our churches, we can be using “the world’s loud rock type music,” not from God that many now grow up with - that can bring Satan worship- (any worship of God???) We can only glorify and worship God by using what comes from Him as a source (from whom and what He is). He does not accept any glory from us - things that come from us and the world as a source (Satan as a source). We can be using low level sermons. Then our people are not being greatly matured. Thus, they are being greatly deterred from having a maximum walk with God in eternity. The Bible teaches indirectly that our maturities will not increase in eternity, by teaching the current development environment will not be in heaven. We are here now for this purpose. This alternative way can be Satanic strategy to transform our churches for his purposes for the endtimes to help win the spiritual warfare.)

or can do on our own.

**3. The Greatest Sin of Our Churches and Satan’s Strategies:** Our greatest sin is our attempting to work things together for good ourselves in our churches and lives caused by using our intellect and things from ourselves and the world as a source, instead of using only things in and from the Bible (only from God as a source), trusting God to do so. (God will work to use our intellect needed in His ministries.) This sin leads to many other sins, we being disobedient to the Bible. Only God has the ability to work all things together perfectly for good and without sin or error. We have no such ability. Working all things together for good was the great sin of Satan and of Adam and Eve. Adam and Eve disobeyed God, eating of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil so they could gain the knowledge needed to work all things together for their good, thinking they could. Today we use the world’s loud rock music and dumb down our Bible training to bring the youth into our churches. We even purposely wear casual clothes in our church services and meetings. Because churches do this, not being outcome and eternity oriented, is one reason many of our youth when they attend college no longer attend church because they do not see the churches going anywhere.

## **PART TWO**

### **MORE DETAILED DISCUSSION**

**1. Items Within the Main Concept We must Know and Live out (Inputs Only from the Holy Bible. Christianity, throughout our lifetimes, is a living dynamic real-time relationship with God. It is not a religion of mainly doctrinal beliefs.)**

We have a most perfect and infinite single God who has always existed and will always exist (has preexistence). He has all the infinite attributes, truths to live by, and character qualities that exist, without any errors or sin of any kind. For example, He works with billions of people and angels all at the same time, and He is always everywhere that exists all the time. He has always known everything that can be known, in the entire past, present, and future. He has created everything that exists, including all universes, angels, and people (us).

**Because God is infinitely perfect, He is the only one who can and will direct our lives in absolute perfection in eternity without any error or sin of any kind. (We, in eternity, will never direct our lives independently of Him - we will not have the ability to do so.) He has planned a perfect future life for us humans that He will direct. He will direct our every thought and action we will ever have according to (commensurate with) our spiritual abilities to respond. We will respond to and obey Him from our love of His Greatness (not as robots), based on the spiritual maturity in Christ-likeness (e.g. ability we have to live by love and by faith) we have at death.**

We are now on earth in our present lifetimes to gain this maturity, needed for eternity, amidst a present developing and testing environment of the world, the flesh, and the devil. This development is so we will respond to God in eternity from our love and faith, and thus, not as robots. God does not force Himself upon us, but allows our choice to respond. But we all should know of God by observing His creation of people, the earth and the universe. Thus, if we do not respond, we are without excuse.

We, in eternity as now, will live by faith that God exists because we will never see Him physically with our eyes - He exists everywhere that exists all the time. This is how He works

in billions of us at the same time. We will see the Lord Jesus Christ and we will gain knowledge of the Father as Christ lives out things from Him as a source. This testing environment is developed from a spiritual warfare between Christ and Satan. Christ works at the direction of God the Father, using especially the Church to have all the elect believe the Gospel and to accomplish all of God’s works. Satan works on His behalf with his angels to prevent at least one of the elect from believing and/or at least one of God’s work from being accomplished.●<sup>5</sup> He uses many strategies such as having religions of false beliefs, influencing the church not to mature their people and not to evangelize the children, especially in the community, and to have governments work for his purposes, including to bring his world rule (in the endtimes). He works to have same sex marriages and abortions so the elect might not be born. Christ must (and He will) win the warfare in order to have the authority, according to the rules of the spiritual warfare, to bring the elect to live with Him in heaven and have unbelievers taken to the Lake of Fire, both for all eternity. This determination is made by the heavenly court “after” the conclusion of the endtimes Tribulation.

Adam and Eve were born with human natures. Satan deceived them to disobey God, breaking God’s laws. This resulted in them now having only sin natures (that are passed down to the human race) that cause them (and us) to sin, breaking God’s laws. With only sin natures (not becoming a Christian), one cannot go to heaven after death. Using His blood to cover over and purge out all our sin, Christ died on the Cross to satisfy God’s justice for our sin (law breaking). Believing this and that Christ was risen from the dead on the third day (all according to the Scripture), and then praying to God that one believes what Christ accomplished and the need of the accomplishment (activating their faith), the satisfied justice is placed to the believer’s personal account. When this happens, the new believer receives a new divine nature, he did not have before. It cannot sin and can take (and can only take) direction from God (none from ourselves). The divine nature now legally represents him. The divine nature is where God develops our spiritual ability (maturity) in Christ-likeness in this lifetime, needed for eternity. God will use it to direct our every thought and action in eternity. Because the divine nature cannot sin, we can not lose our eternal salvation in Christ. Thus, we have eternal security. (The divine nature concept is that God does not put new wine (divine things) into old wine skins - the sin nature. He only puts new wine into new wineskins - the divine nature.)

We still have our sin natures by which we still sin in this lifetime. However, they no longer legally represent us. They are taken from us as we enter heaven (being Christians). We will enter heaven with only our divine natures with the maturity they have. We will be unable to sin in heaven and God will direct our every thought and action. It will be God all in all. All people remaining as unbelievers at their death, will go eternally to the most terrible place of the Lake of Fire (eternal torment, absolute blackness, terrible pain, being all alone, not remembering the past, and separation from God) for the alternate way (to the Cross) for God to satisfy His justice for sin. (Heaven is the infinite best. The Lake of Fire is the infinite worst.)

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**5. BEFORE TIME BEGAN FOR PEOPLE:** God established the spiritual warfare before people came on the earth. From His omniscience, He knew who would choose Him and what works they would do. God calls them His elect. Christ must bring all the elect to believe and to accomplish all of God’s works to win the warfare. Satan to win the warfare must prevent one of the elect from believing and/or prevent one of the works from being accomplished.

**2. Becoming Mature in Christ-likeness. So how do we become maximumly mature in Christ-likeness? The procedure includes at least what follows (we most likely do not know everything involved).** We must follow only our role model of the Lord Jesus Christ who is God. The Bible tells us to live as He lives if we abide in Him (are Christians). So how did He live? He only did and lived out what came from God the Father as a source. So when people saw Him, they actually saw God the Father working out through Him. He glorified His Father because He obeyed what His Father asked Him to do. If we are to glorify and obey God the Father, we must obey what is in His Bible, not from ourselves or the world as a source, as a main directive. Only the Bible is from God the Father as a source as we live today. Thus, everything must be found in the Bible directly or in application.

We should begin by appreciating (to the degree we can) God’s infinite Greatness. Doing so, we will search the entire Bible for all of what He wants us to become (outcome) and for all of the steps what we must live out experientially to get there (procedure). Thus, we must be both outcome and procedure oriented, both from a current and eternity perspective. We will record our findings in a computer and update our findings when we learn more. We must do this to know the great plans God has for us and how we are to live them out. **Then we will live out nothing else, particularly from ourselves, other churches, and the world as sources. (See my previously referenced documents in footnote 3 for key methods of gaining maturity in Christ-likeness.) We can only do God’s work as we obey what God is working in us.** (Not doing these, many or most churches today are falling away, being transformed away from God’s best, resulting in sin - very likely without their realization or desire.)

We must live God’s (not our) ways amidst the trials and testings of life. Appreciating God’s infinite Greatness, we will love Him with our total beings. This will result in our obeying His commandments (we must know what they are). When we do, we live holy and righteously. Obeying His commandments, we activate our love. Then we get to know God. We will also live by faith trusting God to fulfill His promises to us (we must know what they are). We will activate our faith by obeying the instructions with the promises. When we do, we live without sin because both are coming from God as a source. Walking this way by faith, we gain understanding and revelation of the holy Scriptures. When we keep (obey) the commandments from love, we also live without sin, because all is coming from God as a source. (We sin when we do things from ourselves and the world as a source.) We (as Christians) will live without sin when we walk by faith and love, because God is leading us in our divine natures to use the commandments and promises. We will live this way in eternity. We live this way as God works in us to obey His Word and for Him to work all things together for good.●<sup>6</sup>

Other aspects to be lived out to become maximumly mature include the following. We will keep the commandments and promises of God as we live in head-subordinate relationships with God, our employers, in our families, in our country, in our churches, and in the ministry. We will work to maximumly mature our people and families in Christ-likeness, use biblical music such as hymns with dominate melody at normal loudness that we sing from our hearts unto the Lord,

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**6. LIVING BY GOD’S RIGHTEOUSNESS:** This document on our web site presents many of the Bible’s commandments and promises for us to use. I have a web site paper on many more of the promises. I read portions of these documents daily.

and go all out to evangelize the children and the youth out in the community. (We should do this because, as presented, statistics show that 85% of those coming to Christ do so in the age range of 4-14.) We will evangelize adults also. We will also plant new churches and help the needy. We will have a doctrinal statement of our basic doctrinal beliefs for which we would be willing to die (mine is on my web site). We will regularly read our Bibles and pray about all things. We can add others. (We will not use worldly signs on our church buildings and property or in our church bulletins and documents.)

**When we train, we need to train with what to do, how to do it, examples of how we live them out, testimony for how the teacher lived them out, and place our people into places of on-the-job training. We must live out the training to become mature, not just have information, such as mainly knowing Bible facts and teachings. (Thus, just having great Bible knowledge such as one might get in Bible college or seminary, does not make one mature.) Just training mostly with only what to do does not get the job done.**

**NECESSARY ELEMENTS OF A SUCCESSFUL CHURCH (my understanding):** People will attend church in great numbers if they see evidence of “divine life” - not just observing mainly having a sermon and Sunday School. In my experience, the following draws people: **(1)** expository in depth verse by verse teachings of the basic biblical truths from accurate Bibles (e.g King James or New American Standard - never paraphrases) with many examples and testimonies for living the Christian life to gain maturity in Christ-likeness; and **(2)** using the great hymns that people know and love to sing from their hearts unto the Lord. Attendees will become involved in many ministries and many will bring in many ministries. Many will be involved in para-church ministries. There will be regular water baptisms of new believers, signaling evangelism is taking place. There will be seminars of advanced training of topics that helps to complete an entire curriculum, trains in methods to evangelize, and brings new people up to speed. There will be evangelization of the children out in the community. There will be a church choir with wonderful soloists - even also a youth choir. I saw once a pastor quartet. There will be “church divine life” everywhere (not just some activity) that will draw many people to attend. (I attended such a church.)

**PART THREE**  
**WHAT WE SHOULD DO URGENTLY NOW AS THE ENDTIMES ARE UNFOLDING, TERMINATING HUMAN HISTORY**

God is now terminating history using a sequence similar to the ones He used with Israel before the Cross. This is determined by comparing major things and wording (not the details) in Revelation to what happened to O.T. Israel several times. There is a match in the overview sequence aspects (not in the details).

The sequence is as follows using a chosen favored nation (was Israel and is now the United States): God “greatly blesses” His chosen favored nation in her general obedience, “much more” than any other nation. As His people (now the churches) greatly fall away that causes the country to fall away, He brings warning through signs. These signs include what is happening wrong in our churches, country, and weather. These signs “now” greatly signal and warn that God’s disciplinary judgment (the endtimes Tribulation) on the American churches and

country is on our doorstep, can come at any time, again with only God knowing the precise timing. The disobedience continuing, God allows and most likely guides Satan to bring a foreign military that will place the United States and the world under world government ruled by Satan and his forces, used to implement His divine discipline. This will be the endtimes Tribulation. Thus, the Church will experience the Tribulation. Then, in the endtimes, after all people who are to live have lived and have made binding decisions to accept or deny the Gospel, Christ takes all believers to heaven to be with Him (the Rapture). He then destroys (kills and removes) the remaining unbelievers on earth and brings eternity. (In O.T. Israel, the Israelites were returned to Israel’s land and the world empire destroyed.) In eternity, Believers will be in heaven with Christ and God and all unbelievers will be in the Lake of Fire apart from God and Christ.

**NOTE:** The Cross broke down the barrier of the dividing wall between the Jew and the Gentile where now all believers in the Gospel (both Jews and Gentiles) are now one in Christ without ethnic division and are part of His Church. God is now through with Israel being a special nation to Him as of the Cross. God is not through with Jews as people because they, like the Gentiles, can become Christians and gain maturity in Christ-likeness, needed for eternity. Christ is now married to the Church and cannot have two wives at the same time. Thus, He is no longer married to national Israel. The Church goes to live in with Christ at the marriage supper of the lamb which occurs after the endtimes Tribulation. National Israel had great purpose before the Cross. Israel today is mainly one of the nations that will be used in the Calamity to bring in the endtimes Tribulation. Revelation teaches that many-many believers from “all nations” die in the endtimes Tribulation - a number greater than anyone can count. It is not exclusively Jewish that would be required for the all-nations Church to go to heaven before the Tribulation begins and have Israel be a main nation under God in the Tribulation. The situation prevents both.●<sup>7</sup>

Only God knows the timing for when the Tribulation will come. But signs now signal it can come at any time in the next few months to a few years. Our churches must do the following with utmost expediency or they can be caught blind sided as the Tribulation comes without warning apart from the signs like a sudden earthquake when normal things look like they might continue.

Each Church should “now” establish a leadership working group of mature Christians (under the authority of Church elders) to lead and to accomplish the following in the church:

1. Go all out to “maximally” mature their people (not just work for Christian growth), including the children and the youth, in Christ-likeness. The training “must include” walking by strong faith in God to work all things together for good. They must have a detailed description from the Bible of what constitutes a mature person and the detailed steps (curriculum) of the training to get there. Otherwise, they can fall short. There will be seminars to bring new people up to speed. Many churches are now mainly training with only the a,b,c’s so as time progresses and the older people die, hardly anyone will know the Bible, be mature, and will fall away under the coming persecution. This is satanic strategy.
2. Go all out to evangelize the children and youth out in the community as well as their own. They can use Child Evangelization (CEF) as a help for training and establishing the schools

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**7. ISRAEL TO DAY:** Satan uses the return of Israel in 1948 to have Christians believe wrongly in a false Pre-Tribulation Rapture so they will not prepare for the Tribulation and will fall away in the Tribulation under the great persecution. He will use her in wars that will help bring the endtimes Tribulation.

for after school clubs. (CEF has training materials.) We must also evangelize adults.

3. Establish hymn services and bring their people out of the loud rock-music services into the hymn services. Use of loud rock type music can bring worship to Satan and desensitizes one to the leading of the Holy Spirit. Churches that do not have rock-music services should not establish one. One must understand that loud rock beat type music is from the world (not of God - not in the Bible) and was used in Voodooism to call up evil spirits and demons - thus, it is demonic. Being not of God, it should not be used in our churches. **Do the research and you will agree.** Satan is using it to cause our churches to fall away and be transformed. The hymn services should go to expository verse by verse teaching with many examples and testimonies.●<sup>8</sup>
4. Proclaim a watchman warning of coming endtimes events and why they are coming. Train our churches for how the endtimes unfold and what they will experience when they come. They should put in provisions, of all categories, to get (live) through at least the first few months - even much longer.
5. Have missionaries and pastors, financially supported by others, now get several sources of support, including a job. Otherwise their ministry can be greatly effected under coming difficult times and when the Tribulation begins, when the giving greatly decreases.
6. Place our church people now into underground home churches so that when the Tribulation comes, closing our Church buildings, our worship and much ministry can continue. The people can support each other during the soon coming very difficult times.

**NOTE:** Not carrying out the above: **(1) Our people who have not been warned about endtimes events they will experience will be caught blind sided and unprepared;** **(2)** our people will have some maturity, but most likely will not have the needed (desired) maturity they should (need to) have to know and relate more greatly to God in all eternity - this is most terrible - we can expect that we will enter heaven with different levels of spiritual maturities; **(3)** leaders will grieve when they see their people suffering (e.g. being persecuted and martyred) when they had the chance to prepare them and they did not; and **(4)** our people can fall away under the persecution, not standing strong to gain more maturity in Christ-likeness.

**PLEASE NOTE: We must realize that once the Tribulation begins and lasts only a limited number of years, with most dying in the Tribulation, our children and youth, alive as children and youth at that time, will not live normal life spans. Their lives (and ours) will be truncated in the limited years Tribulation. They may not graduate from high school, go to college, or get married. Thus, we need to go all out to evangelize and mature our children and youth “urgently” while we still can. We do not know for sure, but God no doubt will save the children (including those aborted) who have not yet reached the age of God’s accountability and give them some maturity.**

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**8. CATCH 22:** Today with our youth growing up under loud rock beat music, they may not want to come to church unless it is used. Thus, if we terminate rock music services, we may lose much of our congregation. We may have to use it and then privately inform people of its evils and invite them to attend the hymn service.
